- Keep your current account numbers, checks, and debit card
- Use Geauga online banking
- Open new share accounts or apply for loans through Geauga branches
- Enjoy any excess share insurance you currently have

We will reach out with important updates well before any changes to your accounts take place in November. Our goal is to make this transition simple, clear, and stress-free.
